REQUIREMENTS



PHASE 01: You need to be at least 18 years, have a valid EU / EEZ passport before joining any of our partner flight schools.

PHASE 02: You need to have valid EU / EEZ passport, valid EASA pilot license, valid ME/IR ratings, ATPL theory pass certificate, valid 1st class medical, Minimum English level 4.

SCREENING: You will be invited to Berlin (SXF) for a 2-3 day assessment, inclusive accommodation, on site catering and support.

REGISTRATION

SCREENING FEE



499 EUR - including preparation material, test parts 1-4, hotel accommodation, SXF airport shuttle & catering on site!

1. Online Test (day 1)

Cognitive part & Personality part. Cognitive: different exercises to be done in 40 minutes, including math, physics, English tests Personality: consists of statements describing various behaviours, thoughts and feelings.

2. ATPL & General Knowledge Test

Depending on the airline's request, candidates have to answer up to 100 selected questions.

3. Personal Interview (day 2)

Introduction of yourself, strengths and weaknesses, CV and background check.

4. Simulator Assessment (day 3)

NAV setup, briefings, manual flight, SID, airwork, approach, go-around, possible engine failure.



ATPL – Theory, VFR, IFR, SE , ME (depending on flight school up to 2 years).

NGC – The ultimate Next Generation Course
CBT, JOC, MCC, CRM, LOFT, PREP (up to 1 month).

TR – the Type Rating, CPT, FTD, FFS, SKILL CHECK (up to 3 weeks).

LT – Company Conversion & Line Training, BASE TRAINING (1 day), COMPANY
CONVERSION (14 days), LIFUS, LINECHECK.

01 YOUR START



Register now for securing the chance to be given a fully paid training scholarship, we screen and assess students from selected flight schools for our PHASE 1 scholarship, or students already holding an ME/IR rating and/or an ATPL for our PHASE 2 scholarship. 02 YOUR SCREENING



We will invite you to Berlin (SXF), Germany, in our screening and assessment center, where you will be undergoing a typical but yet innovative airline screening, consisting of three stages: multiple online tests, a personal interview and a simulator assessment on our own B737 NG simulator situated in the heart of the Lufthansa Aviation Training Center. 20 TOP TALENTS will be offered a scholarship for their training according to the relevant phase of scholarship they have applied for, followed by a 3 year job offer. All other successful candidates will be offered to join our training on a self funded base, with the job opportunity waiting as well. Screening cost will be 499 EUR (incl. preparation material, test parts 1-4, hotel accommodation, SXF airport/hotel shuttle & catering on site).

03 YOUR JOB



After successfully passing the assessment and the followed training with us, our pilots will then be presented a job offer as First Officer with our airline partners, with aircraft ranging from Turboprops, A320 to B737 classics and NGs depending on the operator/airline you will fly for. Our scholarship is fully paid for the pilots.
